about the NW 48th Street roadway project

Location: Arnold Elementary,
5000 Mike Scholl Street (cafeteria)

Design is progressing on Lincoln's NW 48th Street roadway improvement project. Based on comments from the first public meeting and stakeholder feedback, the design team has created three different roadway alignment alternatives. The public is encouraged to share feedback.

Currently a two-lane roadway, NW 48th Street will be designed as a four-lane divided road between W. Holdrege Street and Highway 34. South of W. Holdrege Street, the road will be designed as a six-lane road to match NDOR's proposed interchange project. Design for the NW 48th Street project began this spring and will be substantially complete by the end of 2014.

Construction for the segment between W. Vine Street and W. Adams Street is tentatively scheduled to take place in 2015, dependent upon the right-of-way acquisition process. The segment between W. Adams Street and Highway 34 is not scheduled for construction at this time, but preliminary design plans will be completed.
